EYELASH APPLICATION TIPS

Tools Needed:

- Eyelashes
- Eyelash Adhesive
- Tweezers or Eyelash Applicator
- Toothpick (optional)

1. Curl your real eyelashes with an eyelash curler. Warming the curler under a blow dryer for approx.3 seconds will help maintain a more permanent curl.



2. Check for fit. Trim eyelashes accordingly. (If the band extendeds further than your natural lash line, shorten by angle cutting the lash band from the outer end, lash by lash



3. Gently peel the lashes off the tray, using tweezers or fingers.




4. Flex the eyelash band by bending the arch like the eyelash is going to go on your eye. Roll in a wave fashion, This allows the eyelash to flex and fit your eye shape and can prevent a corner from lifting off.



3. Hold with an eyelash applicator or a pair of tweezers at the center.



4. Place a thin layer of adhesive to the lash band. An easy method is to dip a toothpick into the glue and brush over the seam of the lash band until you have a small white line with a little extra at the corners. A little bit of glue goes a long way!



- 4. Allow glue to become "tacky" for approximately 10-20 seconds before applying to your eyelid.
- 5. Brush your lashes downward for better access to the lash line.
- 6. Apply the lash band with a light pressure as close to the center of the lash line as possible. Using your tweezers, wedge the glued lash into your natural lashes.



7. Once in place, press each section of the eyelash to the eye lid to allow eyelash to bond. The use of tweezers may be necessary to assist getting the eyelash close the natural lash line.



8. Allow to dry before applying make-up.

REMOVAL:

- 1. Use a gentle non-oil based eye makeup remover to soften the blue. Soak a cotton swab or pad with the remover, brush it on the base of the eyelash and let the false lash slide off.
- 2. Soak a cotton swab with olive oil, coconut oil or any gentle oil-based makeup remover to remove any residual glue on your eyes. The adhesive will lift once it comes in contact with oil.
- 3. Gently peel off any remaining glue on the false eyelash. Do not allow any kind of oil to touch the false eyelash.
- 4. Store false eyelashes for future use.
